## Itinerary

B: Breakfast

### Day 1 Tokyo

Arrive at Narita Airport and take a shuttle bus to check-in to our hotel. The rest of the day is free to explore Tokyo.

### Day 2 Tokyo (B)

After breakfast, visit Tsukji Outer Market, pass by Ginza where there is shopping and entertainment. Next, you'll see Sensoji Temple which is Tokyo's oldest buildings. Visit Nakamise street where you will be able to get Japanese souvenirs like a yukata which is a casual version of the kimono as well as folding fans. Make your way to Meiji Jingu Shrine and Harajuku district. Later, return to the hotel.

### Day 3 Tokyo – Mt. Fuji – Hakone (B)

Today you will be visiting Mt. Fuji 5th station. The station is known to be the most popular of the stations on Mt. Fuji. Or you can go to Iyashino Sato Nemba Village where you can enjoy traditional craft making opportunities, museums, and galleries. Then you'll be transferred to Hakone, west of Tokyo and known for its hot springs, resorts, and views of the volcano Mt. Fuji. Enjoy Lake Ashi pirate cruise & Hakone Ropeway. Afterwards, you'll return to your hotel in Tokyo.

### Day 4 Tokyo (B)

Today is a free day to explore the vast of the city of Tokyo. Call us for optional day tours, such as a day at Tokyo Disneyland/Disney Sea or a one day Yokohama Private Tour.

### Day 5 Tokyo – Osaka (B)

After check-out, transfer to Tokyo Station, where you'll take a bullet train to Shin Osaka Station. Arrive at Osaka Station, and transfer to your hotel for check-in. Have the rest of the time to explore the city on your own.

### Day 6 Osaka (B)

Start your day with a photo stop at Osaka Castle. Later, visit Harukasu Observation Deck also known as "Harukas 300" it occupies the building's top three floors 58 to 60 (tallest building in Japan) on the 60th floor there is a 360 degree view of Osaka and the 58th floor has a designed inner court that has a wooden deck, café, and a souvenir shop and restrooms with views accessible, enjoy shopping in Shinsaibashi & Dotonbori district, and then return to hotel.

### Day 7 Osaka – Kyoto (B)

After breakfast, visit Kinkakuji Temple (Golden Pavilion) which is a Zen temple in northern Kyoto. Make your way to Arashiyama, visit Sagano Bamboo grove and Togetsukyo Bridge. Continue your way to Gion district, visit Hanami Koji Street and Yasaka Shrine. After a full day in Kyoto return to hotel in Osaka.

### Day 8 Osaka (B)

Today is a free day to explore the city of Osaka. You could have the option to have a day at Universal Studios Japan or a one day Amanohashidate Tour.

You then have one last day to spend at your leisure before we escort you to the airport for your flight back home or on to your next destination.
