Itinerary

Day 1 Beijing

Arrive in Beijing after your flight where we will greet and escort you to your hotel.

Day 2 Beijing (AB, L, D)

You will first visit sites of the 2008 Olympic Games such as the Bird's Nest and the Water Cube. After a short rest, you'll visit the Yonghegong Lamasery and Temple of Heaven.

Day 3 Beijing – Lhasa (AB, L, D)

Today, board an early flight to Tibet, "The Roof of the World." Take in the breathtaking countryside as you travel from the remote airport into the city of Lhasa. The remainder of the day will be free for you to explore and adapt to the altitude.

Day 4 Lhasa (AB, L, D)

Today, visit the 7th century Jokhang Temple and Sera Monastery. Afterwards, you will visit Barkhor Street to shop for traditional Tibetan arts and crafts.

Day 5 Lhasa (AB, L, D)

Your first stop will be the Potala Palace, the most sacred location of Tibetan Buddhism. You then visit the Summer Palace of Norbu Lingka, former residence of the Dalai Lama. Later you will see the Tibetan History Museum. Tibetan singing and dancing performance highlights the evening.

Day 6 Lhasa – Namtso (AB, L, D)

Today, drive to one of the Holy lakes in Tibet, Namtso Lake. After admiring the beauty of nature and its natural pure color and return back to Lhasa.

Day 7 Lhasa (AB)

Today is a free day so you may want to set aside some time to go shopping and taste some regional cuisine while in Lhasa.

Day 8 Lhasa – Chengdu (AB, L, D)

In the morning, we board our flight to the city of Chengdu, Sichuan (Szechuan) the gateway to Tibet. After checking into the hotel, we rest up before heading out to enjoy a Sichuan opera in the evening.

Day 9 Chengdu (AB, L, D)

Today we will make our way from Chengdu in the morning, and visit the Giant Buddha at Mt. Leshan. Afterwards we will return to Chengdu in the evening.

Day 10 Chengdu – Dujiangyan (AB, L, D)

Today we'll visit one of the World Heritage Site - Dujiangyan Irrigation System, which is an age-old water project completed more than 2000 years ago. This project has been functioning for over 2000 years guarding against floods and irrigating the vast Chengdu Plain. Head back to Chengdu to visit the Giant Panda Research Center.

Day 11 Chengdu (AB)

Enjoy your breakfast, then we will escort you to the airport.
